Family Background

- Lim Jun Qung: 8 years old, tragically lost both parents (Father: road accident on 24 September 2024; Mother: illness in 2022).
- Lives with elderly grandfather and younger sister (2½ years old with Down syndrome).



Family Challenges

1.  Grandfather's Health:
 - Recovering from stroke; suffers from heart disease.
 - Severe eye condition, risking blindness without urgent treatment.
2.  Younger Sister's Needs:
 - Requires specialized care due to Down syndrome.
3.  Living Conditions:
 - Cramped 10 x 30-foot room, poorly ventilated and unsuitable for young children.
 - Adjacent house is uninhabitable due to termite damage.

Key Issues Identified (10 Jan 2025 Visit)

1.  Unsafe Living Conditions:
 - Cramped and poorly ventilated current space.
 - Adjacent house is uninhabitable due to termite damage.
2.  Grandfather's Eye Health:
 - Immediate treatment needed to preserve vision.

Proposed Solutions

1.  House Refurbishment:
 - Repair termite-damaged house to create a safe and healthy living environment.
 - Improve ventilation and structural safety.
2.  Medical Assistance for Grandfather:
 - Eye specialist consultation for potential surgery or treatment to save vision.
